Monthly meeting
08-06-2012

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Booster Co-President Tony Hayman. Tony took a moment to thank all who showed up for their support.

Treasurer's report:

After going over the annual budget briefly with the attendees, there were a few questions about the amount requested for directors stands. Mr. Arnott explained and answered any questions on the subject. The suggestion of purchasing a scissor lift for the directors was also made and will be taken into consideration.
